To all persons to whom these presents shall come greeting know ye that we Harvey Bram & Polly Bram his wife for divers good causes and considerations thereunto moving especially for one dollar received to our full satisfaction of the Painesville & Hudson Rail Road Company have given granted remised released and forever quit claimed and do by these presents absolutely give grant remise release and forever quit claim unto the said Painesville & Hudson Rail Road Co and assigns forever all such right and title as the said Harvey Bram & Polly Bram have or ought to have in or to the following described land situate in Chagrin Falls township in the State of Ohio and Cuyahoga County known as being lots no 37, 38, 39 & 40 situate on Washington Street also lots no 29, 30, 31 & 32 situate on Sophia Street as shown in the plat of the Village of Chagrin Falls as surveyed by William H. Knapp also another piece commencing at the point the center line of the Painesville & Hudson Rail Road crosses the south line of Sophia Street thence east along said Street to the east side of lot no 29 thence north to the center of Sophia Street thence N 7° E parallel to and one hundred and thirty (30) feet from center line of said Rail Road to the center of Bell St. to a point at right angles and one hundred & forty five feet from center line of said Rail Road thence S 7° W parallel to said center line of Rail Road to a point opposite station 1526 thence south to the south line of Sophia Street thence east along said street to the place of beginning. 
